Thanks to the dedication of the entire NMC family, we are able to report that Fiscal Year 2010 was a very positive year for Northwestern Medical Center.

Our updated mission speaks of providing "exceptional" care for our community. Our staff is living that mission. During FY'10, NMC implemented Meditech, our new enterprise-wide computer system and electronic medical record.
