Northwestern Medical Center, Inc. through the Martin H. Wennar, M.D. Health Professions Scholarship Fund will award one or more scholarships to a graduating high school senior in Franklin County. The amount of the scholarship may vary; in 2023 five scholarships of \$3,000 each were awarded.

This scholarship program was established in 1987 by Dr. Martin Wennar and Peter Georgeopoulos, a former Northwestern Medical Center Chief Financial Officer, to honor academic merit and community service in youth pursuing health care careers. In 2003, the scholarship fund was rededicated to Dr. Wennar, in honor of his long-standing commitment to encouraging health professions.

To fund the scholarships, a black-tie optional dinner has been held each year, featuring a distinguished speaker and award presentations. Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- a. Student's scholastic record**
- b. Student's community service**
- c. Student's plans to enter a health field, other than pre-medicine. One scholarship will go to a student pursuing a career in nursing.**

- Dental Auxiliaries
- Medical Technology
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Radiologic Technology
- Respiratory Therapy
