

THE NMC PALLIATIVE CARE FUND

ESTABLISHMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to summarize the understanding of the Department of Community Relations ("the Founding Donors") and the Northwestern Medical Center, Inc. ("the Hospital") regarding the establishment of the Palliative Care Fund ("the Fund").

INTENTIONS OF THE FOUNDING DONORS

The Founding Donors request, and the Hospital agrees, to establish the Fund based on the following intentions of the Founding Donors:

- The Fund is open for the public to contribute to.
- It is understood that the Hospital reserves the right to change the purpose, to the next closest need, in the rare event that palliative care services are no longer needed and/or supported by the Hospital.

PURPOSE

Distributions from the Fund include, but are not limited to, palliative care services, the healing garden and the comfort cart all intended to support patients and family members with physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs during end of life care. The Fund will continue for as long as current-use gifts sufficient to sustain the Fund are received.

GIFT AND FUND ADMINISTRATION

Gifts to the Fund shall be considered as current-use.

The Fund will be administered prudently and uniformly by Northwestern Medical Center "the Hospital." The Fund will be uniquely accounted for, and will be administered in accordance with Hospital policies and procedures as amended from time to time.


